Attention renters, landlords, housing specialists and anyone interested in learning about fair housing rights and how to stop illegal housing discrimination!

Mental Health Advocacy Services (MHAS) has launched a new project to provide fair housing education and outreach. We will:

- Conduct workshops to educate the public about fair housing rights and steps to take if you feel you are a victim of illegal housing discrimination;
- Distribute fair housing information, including the Fair Housing Tip of the Month, in English, Arabic, Armenian, Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Russian, Spanish, and Tagalog;
- Assist individuals with disabilities with fair housing questions;
- Provide technical assistance to organizations.
